All those taking part gather in one place for pre-dinner drinks. Each course is then served at multiple houses in the village by different hosts and those taking part move from one house to another for each course. You dine with different people for each course. We gather again at the end of the evening in one place for coffee. Most people safari in pairs, but you can go on your own if you prefer. Parents sometimes safari with friends – each hosting a course at their respective homes, taking it in turns between partners to safari out with a friend and babysit at home for the other two courses.

To make the evening work we ask you to host a course if you possibly can. Each host usually caters for themselves plus 6 to 8 guests, although please say if you can only cater for a smaller number. The price you pay for the evening depends on which course you host. The company is more important than an extravagant menu – no course has to be "sit down" - buffet style is very acceptable, hot or cold.
